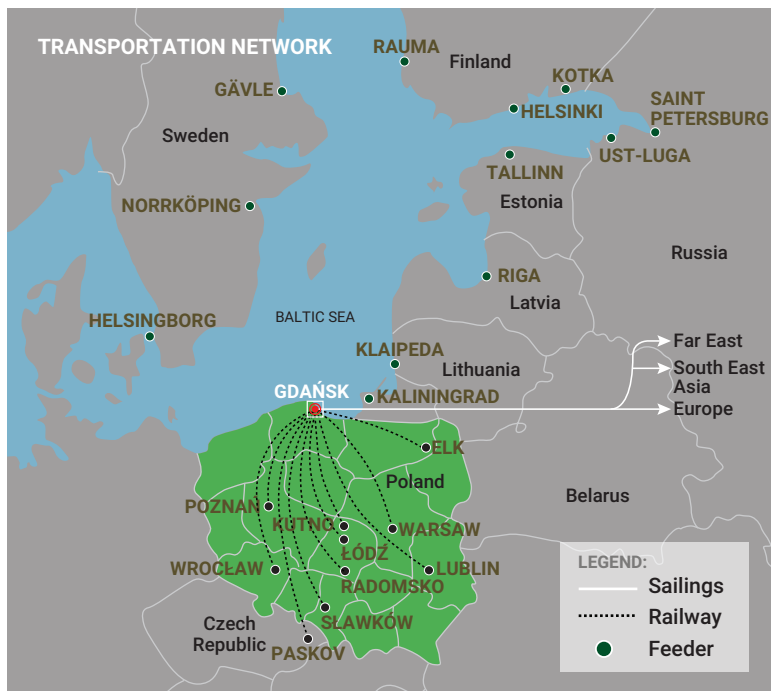

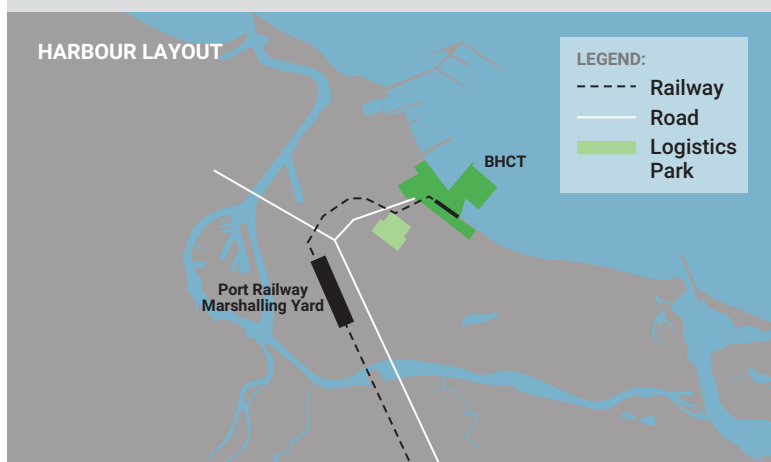

Baltic Hub Container Terminal (BHCT) is Poland's largest container facility and the only deepwater terminal in the Baltic Sea region.

Europe's fastest-growing terminal, BHCT is located in the Port of Gdansk, in the heart of the Baltic region. It is the easternmost facility in the Gdansk–Le Havre range and is the preferred port for direct calls from Asia to the Baltic Sea. BHCT can service the largest container vessels in the world plying the Europe-Asia shipping route.

The terminal handles Polish import, export, transshipment and transit cargo. It is served by a 17-metre deep approach channel and has water depth of 17 metres alongside its berths so ships can arrive or depart without tidal restrictions. BHCT is ice-free and operates year round, 24/7. With its operational excellence, and superior highway and rail links, the terminal is a natural gateway for all Central and Eastern Europe containerised trade volumes. Its strategic position also makes it the most cost-effective location for transshipment to the upper Baltic markets. ■
