Mersin International Port's (MIP) success as the biggest port in Türkiye continues today because of its proximity to major international markets such as the Middle East, North Africa, the Mediterranean, Europe, the Black Sea as well as to North America and the Far East, with direct calls that have drawn many businesses to its shores.

Connected to more than 100 international ports and located in the southeast of Türkiye, MIP remains a key gateway to the eastern Mediterranean. The terminal plays a critical role in the economy and trade of southern and southeastern Türkiye, and the inland transit markets of neighboring countries such as northern Iraq and Syria. It is also well connected via highways and the southern railroad hub to all provinces. Çukurova airport, with frequent flight connections, is only 45 kilometres away.

Adjacent to the port is the Mersin Free Zone, the first free zone established in Türkiye in 1986 where warehouses, manufacturing, packing-repacking, assembly-disassembly, engineering, leasing and exhibition facilities are located.

As part of the East Med Hub (EMH) expansion, a new annex has been added to MIP's terminal facility. With this development, MIP is the only terminal in the region capable of handling vessels that are 387 metres long, have a draft of 15 metres and a total capacity of 18,000 TEUs. This is possible due to MIP's cranes that have an outreach of 24 rows and can reach 49.5 metres high.
