

#### TRANSPORTATION NETWORK




Busan Port is a leading maritime hub in Northeast Asia, offering direct connectivity to major trunk routes linking China, Japan, and North America. Supported by strong inland transport links and deep-water infrastructure, the port provides reliable, high-efficiency operations suited for global transshipment and mainline volumes. Within this network, Busan New Port serves as the core deep-water gateway and a critical platform for large-scale container handling.

Pusan Newport International Terminal (PNIT) anchors PSA's presence in Busan with 84 hectares of terminal area, three deep-water berths extending 1.2 kilometres, and advanced handling systems designed to support 3.25 million TEUs annually. With modern equipment and the operational standards of PSA's global network, PNIT consistently delivers high productivity and dependable service for major carriers across long-haul and regional trades.

Directly across from PNIT, the HMM PSA New-Port Terminal (HPNT) provides a complementary platform purpose-built for HMM and its partners. HPNT encompasses 55 hectares with three berths along a 1.15-kilometre quay, a maximum depth of 17 metres, and a designed capacity of 2.75 million TEUs. Its modern infrastructure and efficient operating model support fast vessel turnaround and strengthen the performance of HMM's global service network.

Together, PNIT and HPNT offer a combined designed capacity of 6 million TEUs and form a highly capable dual-terminal cluster within Busan New Port, reinforcing Busan's position as a dependable and competitive gateway for international trade. ■

#### HARBOUR LAYOUT






