


PSA Panama International Terminal (PPIT) is one of the most productive terminals in Latin America and is located on the Pacific side at the former US Rodman Naval Base. The terminal is well-positioned to participate in the growth of this strategic hub and provides an important port of call for shipping lines handling containers.

With 11 quay cranes, including eight super post-Panamax quay cranes and three remote-controlled rail-mounted gantry yard cranes, PPIT has an annual capacity of up to 2 million TEUs, thereby contributing to employment and the economy of the country. In 2024, the terminal achieved a record-breaking throughput of 1,476,398 TEUs, reflecting a 33.8% year-on-year growth, further strengthening its role as a key enabler of trade in the region.

As PPIT celebrates its 15th anniversary in 2025, it continues to invest in automation, digitalization and operational efficiency. Key initiatives include the full remote operation of its 12 RMG yard crane fleet, new security and digitalization projects and enhanced facilities for employees. These advancements reinforce PSA Panama's position as the Port Hub of the Americas, driving global connectivity and sustainable growth. ■
