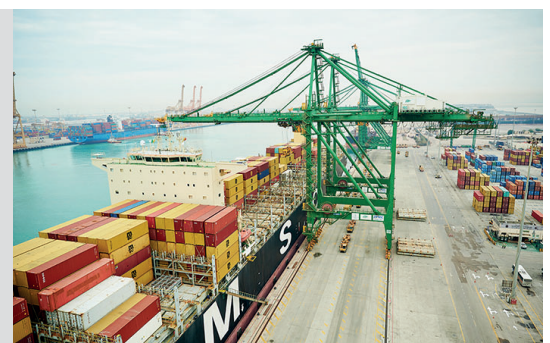
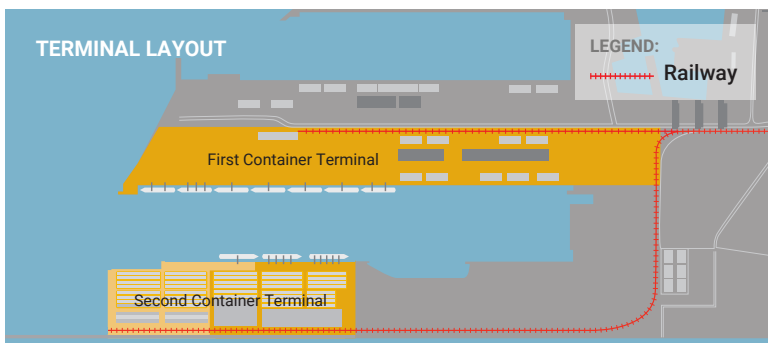
King Abdulaziz Port Dammam is Saudi Arabia's maritime gateway to the Arabian Gulf. It serves the Kingdom's economic centre and capital city, Riyadh, and other major cities in the Eastern and Central regions through extensive rail and road networks.

SGP has committed to development and modernisation plans to grow the container terminals' capacity up to 7.5 million Twenty-foot Equivalent Units (TEUs) over its 30-year concession at King Abdulaziz Port Dammam.

SGP, through its subsidiary, SGP Intermodal, also operates and manage the Riyadh Dry Port Ecosystem (Riyadh Dry Port, Riyadh Empty Yard and Dammam Empty Container Yard), a network of rail-linked inland nodes across Dammam and Riyadh that connects to King Abdulaziz Port Dammam. The SGP Saudi Arabia ecosystem provides customers with integrated and reliable services moving cargoes across the Kingdom.
