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TUAS PORT MARKS 25 MILLION TEUS AS PSA SINGAPORE ADVANCES THE FUTURE OF PORT OPERATIONS

PSA Singapore (PSA) has achieved a significant milestone, handling 25 million twenty-foot equivalent units (TEUs) at Tuas Port since operations commenced in September 2022. This achievement reflects the continued ramp-up of operations at the world's largest fully automated container terminal and underscores Tuas Port's growing importance as a key node in global trade.

As maritime trade continues to evolve amid shifting geopolitical dynamics, Tuas Port continues to serve as a critical gateway for resilient, reliable and efficient cargo flows.
