Puerto Aguadulce handles its 1 millionth container

 Puerto Aguadulce received the container that marks the 1 millionth TEUs that has arrived at the port terminal

Buenaventura, January 8, 2021.- Sociedad Puerto Industrial Aguadulce began operations in 2016 and has now received its 1 millionth container in the port of Buenaventura, Valle del Cauca. This is an important milestone for the organization testifying to the growing options and opportunities in foreign trade for the country of Colombia.
