The first joint Sustainability Report for the PSA Italian terminals

Today, 19th July 2022, the first joint Sustainability Report of the Italian terminals of the PSA group was presented: PSA Genova Pra' and PSA SECH in the Port of Genoa and PSA Venice- Vecon in the Port of Marghera.

The Report, drawn-up according to the international GRI guidelines, includes all of the sustainability objectives reached by the terminals in 2021 and the two preceding years, attesting to the importance of operating in a sustainable and responsible manner, with the territory in which the three companies operate always at the forefront and rooted in their business strategy.

Among the most significant results reached during 2021, special mention should be made of the first PSA forest created by planting 300 trees, the expansion of the railway connections to and from the terminals, which led to a substantial reduction in CO2 emissions, and the increase in the percentage of renewable energy used at the three terminals.

Furthermore, the Report also provides examples of innovations that bring together production efficiency and environmental sustainability, showing how the two concepts are complementary in the PSA group's global strategy. Steps in this direction are the modular reefer park at PSA Genova Pra' capable of adapting to current traffic volumes; the new automatic gate at PSA SECH, that reduces truck waiting times at the entrance thus cutting CO2 emissions, and the radiometric portal at PSA Venice-Vecon that, by allowing checks to be made directly upon unloading, reduces the number of movements and speeds-up operations.

PSA ITALY, which groups together the three terminals PSA Genova Pra', PSA SECH and PSA VENICE, aims to increasingly integrate the poles of Genoa and Venice, with a view to synergistic cooperation in order to offer its customers a single interlocutor that can guarantee an integrated service and various solutions on the logistics and terminal panorama in Northern Italy.

PSA Genova Pra'

Founded as Voltri Terminal Europa, PSA Genova Pra' is the main container terminal in the North Tyrrhenian Sea and has a share of approximately 60% of the container flow handled in the Port of Genoa. With its 650 employees and continuous investments in innovation, PSA Genova Pra' can simultaneously serve three Ultra Large Container Vessels each with a capacity of 20.000 TEUs, accommodate over 1.500 reefer containers, handle 120 trains per week and serve 2.400 trucks per day. Since acquiring the Terminal in 1998, the PSA International Group has invested approximately 600 million euros in its growth and development.

PSA SECH

Born as Terminal Container Port of Genoa or SECH, PSA SECH is located at Calata Sanità, in the heart of the port of Genoa. The ideal location of the port in which it operates and its strategic proximity to access by sea, rail and land make it an optimal basis for unloading and loading operations and for land connections with logistics nodes, favoring penetration towards the productive areas of northern Italy and southern Europe. As of summer 2020, PSA SECH is controlled by the PSA Group.

PSA VENICE

Born as VECON, PSA VENICE is the main container terminal in the Port of Venice. Thanks to its strategic position at the northernmost point of the Adriatic Sea, it is the natural gateway to the rich industrial hinterland of North East of Italy towards the Eastern Mediterranean and the Middle East. The terminal is located within a natural lagoon, which allows it to proceed with port operations without risk for navigation. The Port of Venice is connected to the national and international railway and to the trans-European networks.
